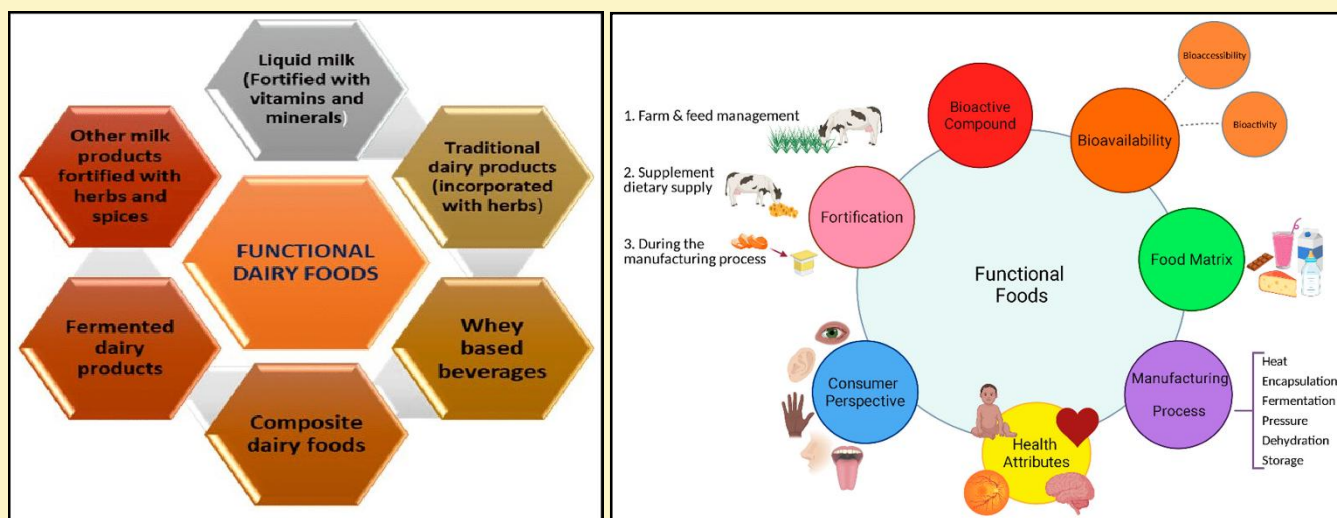

In this training, we aim to train and educate the young talents/newly recruited academicians/scientists to help them pursue cutting edge research in dairy and food science.

Focus Areas:

The major course contents to be covered in the training programme are:

- Valorization of food and dairy wastes for production of various products
- Recent methods and advances in food waste management
- Sustainable bioconversion of food waste to high value products by use of different techniques

Who can Apply

All Researchers/Academicians who are in permanent position as Scientist or Assistant Professor or equivalent in any **ICAR** recognized Institutes/ Central Agricultural Universities/SAUs/KVK. The candidate should be from ICAR system including from private ICAR-accredited Colleges/Universities. Preference will be given to the Food Science/Post Harvest Management/Food Technology/Process Engineering working in ICAR Institutes, Central Agricultural Universities and SAUs and KVKs.

Travel, Boarding Lodging

Expenses on boarding and lodging (on Sharing Basis) arrangements for selected participants will be borne by the organizers. Travelling Allowances (TA) will be paid to all the selected participants (restricted to the maximum of AC II fare by the shortest route as per ICAR norms). Participants are required to produce the original and photocopies of tickets in support of their claim.

 - A registration fee (non-refundable) of Rs. 1000/- per participants, Rs. 5000/- in case of candidates from private ICAR-accredited Colleges/Universities may be fixed and the same may be collected from the participants at the time of their online registration for joining the training.
